TD Banknorth Craftsbury Marathon

Saturday, February 2, 2008

A point-to-point classical technique cross-country ski adventure traversing Vermont's Northeast Kingdom.



Presented by the Craftsbury Outdoor Center, the marathon starts high on the snow covered hills of Greensboro dropping a thousand feet through three scenic villages and climbing to the finish on Craftsbury Common. You have the option of racing or touring 25 or 50 kilometers. Along the way over 170 volunteers will provide you with delicious home cooked food and drink, make sure the road crossings are covered with snow, and staff ten warm, comfortable aid stations. After your finish you will be treated to a hearty post ski meal. All racers are invited to an awards ceremony featuring locally crafted pottery and medals for the top age class skiers and a huge drawing of merchandise donated by ski industry sponsors. All tourers will be presented with a commemorative medal on completion of the 25 km course.

- On-line registration opens Nov. 1 at www.craftsbury.com.
- Early registration is \$75 for racers and \$65 for tourers. Off line registration available for additional cost.
- The limit of 1000 skiers often reached as early as December.
- Registration closes January 26, 2008 unless the event is already filled.
- Your entry is refundable up to Jan. 26, minus a service charge.
- Pasta dinner and early packet pick up Friday, Feb 1 from 6 to 8 PM.
- Race and tour packet pickup and buses to start from 6:45 to 10:00 PM.
- Three wave starts for racers including a women only wave depart Highland Lodge in Greensboro beginning at 9:00 AM.
- Touring skiers depart Highland Lodge between 9:35 and 10:30 AM.



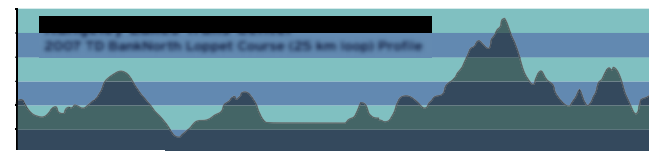
TD Banknorth Rangeley Lakes Loppet XII

The 12th Rangeley Lakes Loppet, on Saturday, March 1st, will add something new, a separate start 25k Classic division, the Burt Kettle Klassic. Both the Classic and the Skate participants will ski the same loop, but the Classic racers will start one hour before the Skate racers.

The stadium is large and user friendly. The trails are wide and will feature set track beside the skate lane starting at 250 meters into the course. Sweeping views of nearby mountain ridges and lakes reinforce the feeling that you're really skiing the "Outer Limits". Spectators witness the thrill of a speeding blur of color as the racers leave the
